## **Mentorship Program for Class of 2024**

## **Purpose**

The purpose of the American Association of Legal Nurse Consultants (AALNC) Mentorship Program is to enhance the skills of novice legal nurse consultants to inspire and empower them to achieve their full potential in the legal nurse consulting career path.

#### **Overview**

The AALNC Mentorship Program is a 12-month mentorship program designed to support the legal nurse consultant (LNC) in their career. The Mentorship Program will provide a unique match with a seasoned LNC to accompany and guide them on their 12-month journey. In addition to enrollment in the Mentorship Class of 2024 and cohort networking opportunities, participants will receive

- One-on-one mentorship with their mentor match throughout the 12 months, with a minimum of a monthly check-in.
- Mentorship Program Guidebook, outlining program expectations, recommended meeting frequency with suggested topics, and additional information.
- 50% off registration for AALNC's 2024 Annual Forum and Pre-Forum in Pittsburgh, PA, taking place April 18-20, 2024 (travel and lodging not included)
- In-person networking experience with Class of 2024 and its mentors at AALNC's 2024
  Annual Forum
- Virtual networking experiences with Mentorship Class and its mentors throughout the calendar year
- Complimentary access to identified AALNC tools and resources
- Discounted registration for LNC Jumpstart Virtual Workshop in 2024
- Access to dedicated Shared Interest Group

AALNC Mentorship Program Class of 2024 will begin in January 2024, and run for the duration of the 2024 calendar year.

#### Qualifications

Applicants must be

AALNC member in good standing

- Practicing RN for at least 3 years
- Practicing LNC for 5 years or less
- Interested and invested in personal professional development to pursue an LNC career
- Any clinical background or practice area

## **Application Process**

- Complete application
- Submit CV/resume
- Submit personal letter of interest (max. 2000 words) that addresses the following points:
  - What are your primary and secondary goals for personal professional development that you would like this program to fulfill?
  - Where do you see your LNC career going in the near future?
  - If you participated in a mentorship program previously, what was it for and what did you like or dislike?
  - Describe the level of time commitment you intend to devote to participation in this mentorship program.
  - o Describe your interest in the LNC field and your experience thus far.

- What is your primary practice area?
- How many years have you held a nursing license?

### **Tuition**

This program is only open to AALNC members in good standing. An application fee of \$50 is required in order for your application to be complete. Tuition is \$1,999, to be paid in full at time of acceptance and program launch in January 2024.
